"America has always been known as the land of opportunity. For that reason, it has drawn immigrants like a magnet. Its exceptionalism, however, is based on something more than the asylum it offers to exiles. It is exceptional because it makes flight unthinkable for its own people. The land of the free, home of the brave, keeps its own in a way equaled nowhere else. America builds walls not to imprison its own people – as authoritarian states do – but to preserve liberties and opportunities for its own people. My story illustrates this in a most dramatic though not unique way. When my business was burned down during the Rodney King riots in the early 90s, I did not flee the United States to find security elsewhere. I rebuilt on the promise of freedom and prosperity here. Time and again we see this scenario: even people who bewail their condition in the United States are virtually never tempted to find refuge elsewhere. By the testimony of their own conduct, America is the only place to live. That exceptionalism is not a declaration of superiority to other human beings; it is a celebration of blessings enjoyed nowhere else to a like degree. A land favored by God's generous hand rightfully calls itself exceptional. "

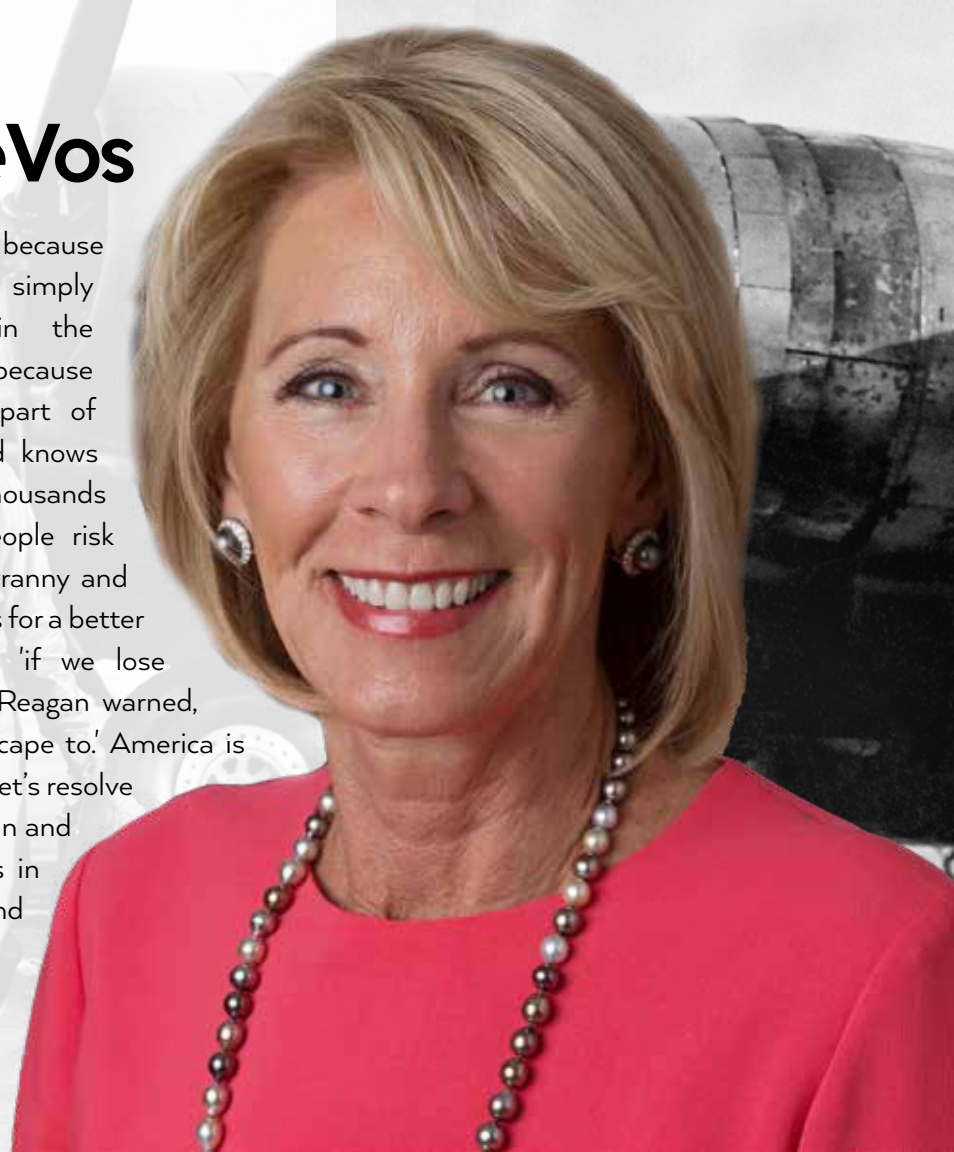

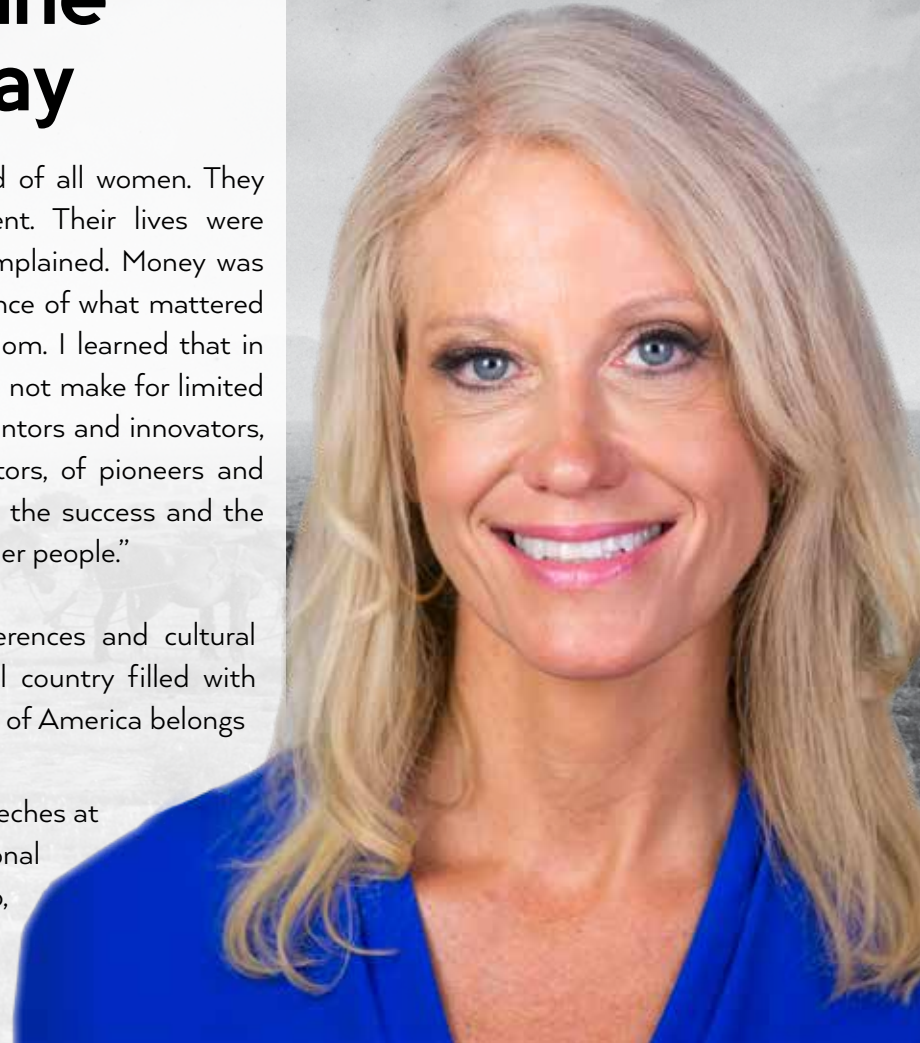


Kellyanne Conway

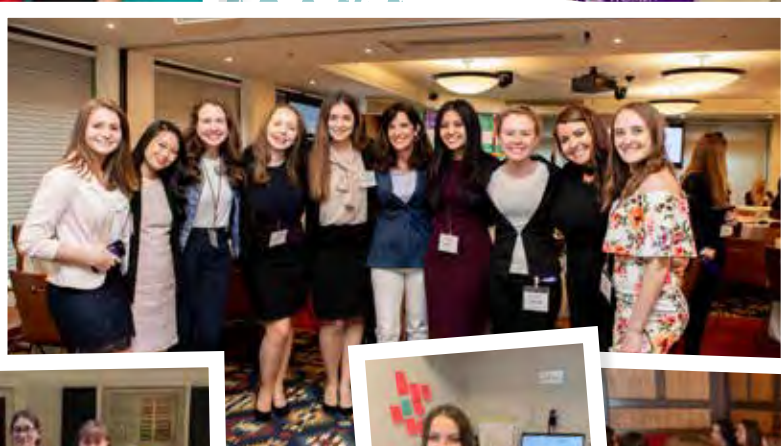
