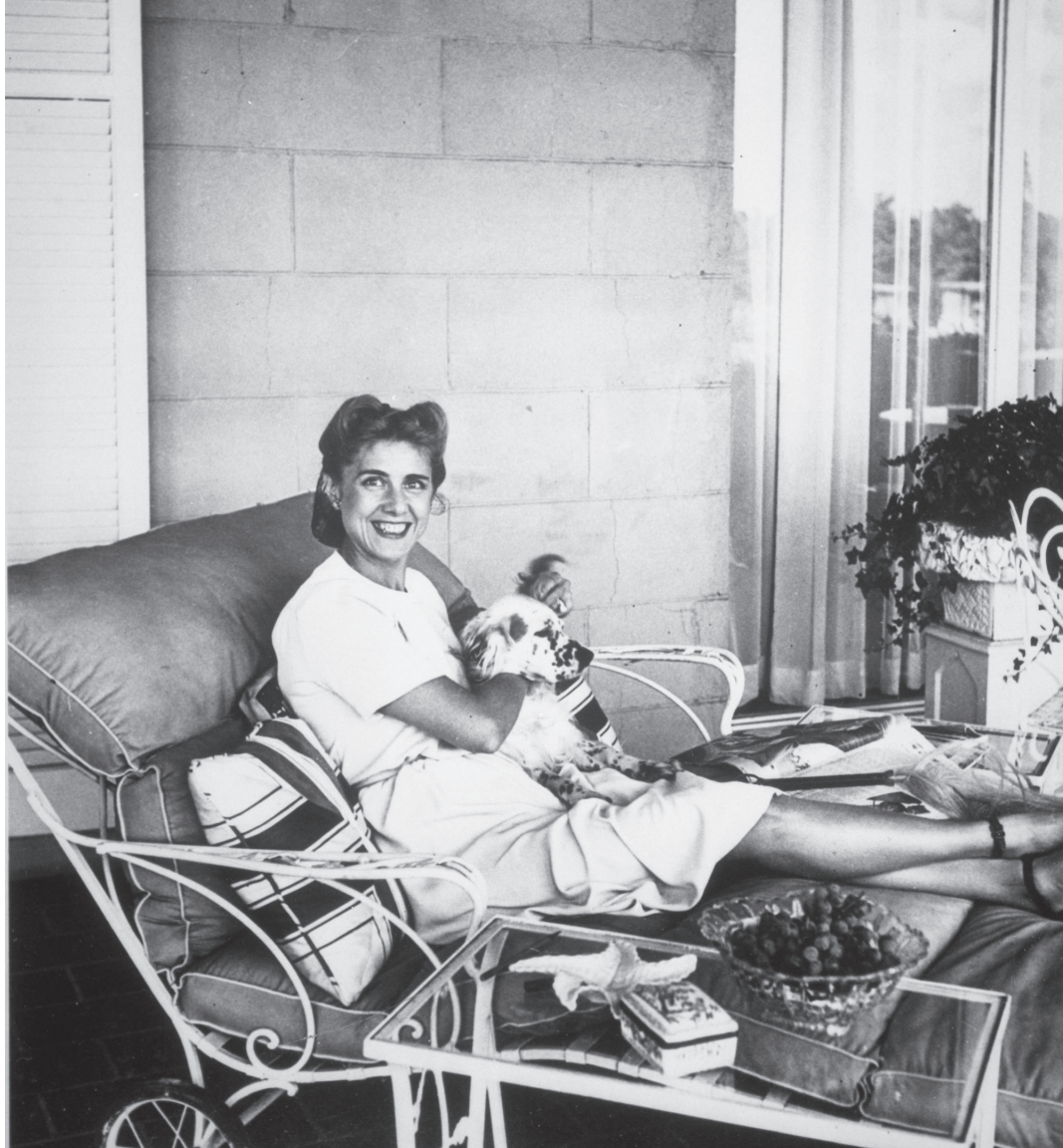


Liz Wheeler
